



# The Holy Sacrament of Baptism

## This is called a Baptismal Record.

The place of Baptism is where all Sacramental Records are kept.

You will need to request a new certificate each time you receive a Sacrament:

- First Holy Communion
- Confirmation
- Marriage
- Holy Orders

Notations are made on the back stating the day the Sacrament was received, the name of the Church, and Priest that presided.

The place of Baptism will provide a signature and a **raised seal with the current date of request.**

**This is what we look for. Your souvenir certificate will not be accepted even with a seal. We must have a CURRENT Baptismal record.**

When your child receives his/her First Communion in May, we will record it in our books, but then we must notify the place of Baptism so they can record it as officially taken place.
