How does this work?

- Children attend the 9:00 AM Mass with their families.
- Children will be dismissed to our classroom after they have heard Father’s homily.
- We will tell each other what we heard in Mass during the readings, Gospel & homily.
 - We may watch a short video.
 - We will spend some time in prayer.
 - We will spend time laughing.
- We may spend some time on art projects.
- We will learn about the Holy Trinity by reading & studying the Bible.
- We will prepare for our sacraments as we build our relationship with God.
- We will learn about the ordinary people who knew Jesus, had meals with Him & sometimes went fishing with Him.
- We will learn about the Saints and just how ordinary they were in their lives, but extraordinary in their love for God.
 - We will share our new relationship with God with our families.
- Families will create a “Journey With Jesus” journal in which they share all the churches they attend on vacations and long weekends.
- Parents will work with their children at home in workbooks that are periodically checked in class.
 - Children will receive sacraments when THEY are ready, not just because the calendar says it is time.
